

What is MTSS?

- A Multi-Tiered
 System of Support
 (MTSS) for All
 Students.
- Comprehensive,
 Standards-Aligned
 School Improvement
 Framework
- Tiered Approach to Intervention
 - Drop-Out Prevention



Tier 1

- Standards Aligned Core Instruction For All Students (100%)
 - PA Core Standards-Based Instruction
 - "Core Curriculum" = POS Task List
 - Whole Group/Small Group/Individual
 - Utilizes Effective Instructional Strategies
 - Learning Guides, MAX Teaching
 - High Expectations, Meaningful Student Engagement, Reinforcing Grading System
 - Assignments, Assessments, Rubrics

Tier 2

- Targeted Group Instruction for Some Students (15-25%)
 - Strategic Instruction- Supplemental to Core Instruction and Explicit in Nature
 - Guided Practice, Small Group Instruction, Targets Specific Skills, Extend Core Instruction
 - Evidence-Based Instructional Strategies/ Interventions and Progress Monitoring
 - Behavioral Interventions and Attendance Monitored

Tier 3

- Intensive Instruction For A Few Students (5-10%)
 - Intensive Focus of Targeted Instruction
 - Individual Intervention
 - Immediate, Corrective Feedback and Intensive Instruction
 - Behavior Interventions and Attendance Monitored
 - Intensive Support Structure
 - District Involvement, SAP Referral
