Good Evening STC Parents:

This morning, Governor Wolf and PA Education Secretary Rivera announced that all public schools will remain closed through the end of the 2019-2020 academic year. All of these decisions were made in consultation with the Secretary of Health, based on the most recent information regarding COVID-19 as it relates to the health, safety, and welfare of students, school staff, and communities.

I am sure this announcement will provoke a number of questions:

- **Graduation-** More details will be forthcoming from your home school districts in the near future regarding details.
- **Grades:** Grades for the Second Semester of 19/20 will be based on the work completed in the third marking period. STC will be sending report cards on 4/17/20.
- **Students Belongings-** We understand that students have personal belongings in the STC buildings. We will make arrangements for students to pick up belongings as soon as the Governor lifts the "shelter in place" guidelines.
- **Events-** it is our sincere hope to reschedule planned B cycle events if possible, once it is safe to do so. More details will be forthcoming.
- **Enrichment & Review-** STC will continue to provide Enrichment and Review lessons for the remainder of the 19/20 calendar year. Hard copies will be mailed to students without internet access.

We understand the current circumstances are stressful for students. STC will be offering an open online forum tomorrow, 4/17/20 at 11am for students to talk with counselors.
