# STC COOPERATIVE EDUCATION INTERNSHIPS

**SCHOOL DISTRICT INTERNSHIP** (paid or unpaid): STC students may work in a school district sponsored internship experience pending approval from their instructor, home school and STC staff. This short term (one to two weeks) work-based program requires specific hands-on training related to the student's occupational Program of Study.

Realizing the value of providing STC students with opportunities in the workforce, it is the intent of the Schuylkill Technology Center to cooperatively partner with our sending school districts to provide internships to further assist the technical student successfully through his/her career pathway.

<b>DISTRICT INTERNSHIP EXAMPLES:</b>	
<b>Carpentry</b>	Interior finish / door installations
<b>Diesel Technology</b>	Bus / heavy equipment repairs
<b>Culinary Arts</b>	School cafeteria tasks
<b>Masonry</b>	Concrete slab finishing / hardscape
<b>Small Engine Tech.</b>	Lawnmower / snow blower repairs
